

TORNADO WARNING!

Those words should catch your attention! If you remember the 1965 Fridley tornadoes, those words conjure up many images and emotions. Unfortunately, younger generations need to be aware of the extreme danger that tornadoes and violent weather pose to our lives.

Less than a week ago, Larry Cotlar, a famous Iowa sportscaster lost his life in a flash flood created by a massive weather system that spawned numerous tornadoes in the area. On February 24th and April 13th of this year, tornadoes claimed the lives of three people and injured many others.

When the storm sirens sound or the words "TORNADO WARNING" are used, get to shelter immediately. Get to the lowest level of your house or apartment with little or no windows! Get out of your car and go to the nearest ditch or low area! Get out of any trailer houses and go to the nearest storm shelter that the complex has in the event of severe weather.

These simple tips could save your live and the lives of your loved ones. It is important to teach your children and grand children how to survive a tornado or severe weather event.

The meeting was called to order at 4:30pm.

Secretary Report: Lori submitted the meeting minutes from June 3rd, 2018. Al made a motion to approve, seconded by Mary Ann, and approved by all.

Treasurer Report: Judy submitted the balance sheet as of June 30th, 2018, Profit and Loss Comparison as of June 2018. Lori made a motion to approve which was seconded by Al and approved by all.

Committee Reports:
