Maintenance Update and Construction Review	The fire exit light needs to be changed out and that the back basement door's bottom area is being fixed. Tom Gamms continues working on the trim work for the elevator and he has put in 30 hours of work so far. The west basement wall has been painted a charming light blue gray. The Buzz's Barbershop sign has been hung. For the new elevator to be ADA compliant, a new phone line will need to be installed, along with lights by the elevator shaft. Some highlights of the new elevator: hydraulic (so much quieter) and wider doors. A full museum clean-up is planned before the May 3 opening.
